- **Housing:** Our team will connect you to local resources which includes mortgage assistance, first-time home ownership, local realtors, home repair resources, and services.
- **Health Coverage:** We provide information and enrollment assistance for Ingham Health Plan and Medicaid. Interns and staff will help with faxing information and getting you the coverage you qualify for.
- **Canvassing:** Our interns and staff walk the Eastside to share news and resources about the Center and to hear from our neighbors about 'state of the neighborhood' and how conditions can be improved.
- **Market Walk and Market Moves:** We encourage exercise by providing tokens to the Farmers Market as incentives for exercising.
- **Allen Farmers Market:** A year-round Wednesday market connecting residents with fresh local produce and other locally produced food products.
- **Hunter Park Garden House:** A year-round urban farm & garden and education facility, located in the Eastside Hunter Park.
- **Breadbasket Food Pantry:** Every Tuesday, free bread, pastries, and produce are available to Eastside residents from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM. **Free to all**
- **Eastside Neighbor:** A newsletter covering ANC events and neighborhood happenings, distributed 3X/year to the door of 3000 homes and in businesses along Eastside corridors.
- **Youth Programs:** Year-round after-school and summer Take Root Garden Club and Youth Service Corps programs for youth in the area interested in nutrition and gardening at the Hunter Park Garden House.
